From Maine Turnpike, take Exit 75. Turn right on to Washington Avenue. Take next right onto Kittyhawk Avenue, about 1/4 mile from the exit. At the next stop sign, take a right onto Hotel Road. Proceed to the four way stop sign/flashing red light (approximately 3.5 miles) at the Rodman Road and Manley Road intersection. AVCOG is on the left after the intersection.

From Franklin County: South on Route 4 to Auburn. Route 4 becomes Center Street in Auburn. Follow Center Street for approximately 5 miles. Bear right onto Union Street By-Pass at the intersection of Center Street, Turner Street and Union Street By-Pass. At the four-way intersection of Court Street and Minot Avenue, turn right onto Court Street. At next light continue straight onto Manley Road and proceed to the four way stop sign/flashing red light, AVCOG is on the right just before the intersection of Rodman Road and Manley Road.

From Oxford County: East on Routes 11/121 to Auburn. At the four-way intersection of Court Street, Manley Road and Minot Avenue, turn right onto Manley Road. Proceed to four way stop sign/flashing red light at the intersection of Rodman Road and Manley Road. AVCOG is on the right just before the intersection.

Southbound from I-295:

Take the Congress St. Exit 5B. Turn right onto Congress Street then immediately take first right onto Douglass St. (Johnson's Sporting Goods on corner of Congress and Douglass Streets). Go to the end. Parking lot is across the street from the training center.

Northbound from I-295: Take Congress St. Exit. After exit, move immediately into right lane and stay right around the clover leaf towards Transportation Center. At end of ramp, stay right onto Fore River Parkway. Go straight through one set of lights and continue on Fore River Parkway to end.

(Hint: Stay in the middle lane because just ahead the two left lanes will have left arrows onto Congress Street, you will want to be in the outside left turning lane). Turn left on Congress Street then immediately take first right onto Douglass St. (Johnson's Sporting Goods on corner of Congress and Douglass Streets). Go to the end. Parking lot is across the street from the training center.

FROM SOUTH: Travel I-95 and take Exit 127 (Oakland – Kennedy Memorial Drive). Turn RIGHT at light at end of exit ramp onto Kennedy Memorial Drive (KMD) going towards Waterville. Proceed east on KMD for ~ 1.5 miles (6 traffic lights).

Move to right hand lane at 6th light (West River Rd.) and take the ramp for the Carter Memorial Bridge. Move to left lane immediately after ramp and take the first left (Grove St.). Drive to the end of Grove St. ~ ½ mile to Water St.

Turn right onto Water St. and drive 1 mile, the main building is directly ahead, the KSTD main entrance is the driveway bearing to the right.

FROM NORTH: Travel I-95 and take Exit 127 (Oakland – Kennedy Memorial Drive). Turn LEFT at light at end of exit ramp onto Kennedy Memorial Drive (KMD) going towards Waterville. Proceed east on KMD for ~ 1.6 miles (7 traffic lights).

Move to right hand lane at 7th light (West River Rd.) and take the ramp for the Carter Memorial Bridge. Move to left lane immediately after ramp and take the first left (Grove St.). Drive to the end of Grove St. ~ ½ mile to Water St.

Turn right onto Water St. and drive 1 mile, the main building is directly ahead, the KSTD main entrance is the driveway bearing to the right.
